AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION IN TOBACCO CONTROL ACTIVITIES **BETWEEN**

THE JAPANESE ASSOCIATION OF SMOKING CONTROL SCIENCES AND

THE KOREAN SOCIETY FOR RESEARCH ON NICOTINE AND TOBACCO

The Japanese Association of Smoking Control Sciences (hereinafter referred to JASCS) and the Korean Society for Research on Nicotine and Tobacco (hereinafter referred to KSRNT) enter into an Agreement of Cooperation to establish a program of exchange and collaboration in tobacco control activities between two academic Societies.

For this purpose, both Societies will

- 1. Exchange speakers for the joint conference alternately.
- 2. Exchange materials including journals, and
- 3. Promote other forms of cooperation, as agreed upon and encouraged by both societies.

The activities under this understanding will be conducted and financed by mutually agreed arrangements. In principle, each Society shall bear the expenses for its own participants.

This Agreement will enter into force upon signature by both societies and will remain in effect for two (2) years. The Agreement will be renewed automatically for equal periods, unless it is terminated, with a 60-days written notice by either society. Both societies shall be terminable without penalty. If this agreement is terminated, neither JASCS nor KSRNT shall be liable to the other for any monetary or other losses that might result.
